The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 77 dated 09.04.2018 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 registered at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that pursuant to the order dated 30.01.2020 petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court on 31.01.2020.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and witnesses have been examined, the instant petition is allowed and the

order dated 30.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
