The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.37 dated 05.05.2019 registered
under Section 323 IPC (Section 455 IPC added later on) at Police Station
SGN, Dev Thermal, Bathinda.

On 20.12.2019, this Court had passed the following order : -

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it
is a case of version and cross-version. On the version of
petitioner, cross-case was registered in which Sections
325 and 326 IPC have been added vide DDR entry dated
06.06.2019.*

*Notice of motion for 19.03.2020. List with CRM-M-
39069- 2019.*

*Petitioner is directed to surrender before the police
and join investigation within two weeks. In the event of his
arrest being required, he shall be released on interim bail
till the next date, subject to his furnishing bonds to the*

satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, he shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which he shall lose the benefit of interim bail allowed to him. ”

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore-quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency; investigation in the case is over and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 20.12.2019, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
