2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.41 dated 17.07.2019 registered under Sections 304 & 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, Tehsil and District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 20.12.2019, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that her custodial interrogation is not required, besides Police has also submitted cancellation report before the learned trial Court.
