Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Short reply dated 13.07.2021, by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Payal, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Perusal of the record would reveal that after conducting inquiry in the matter, FIR No.07 dated 12.02.2020, under Section 379 IPC, Police Station Doraha, has been registered against respondent No.4- Amarjit Singh @ Nanak. It is also stated in the said affidavit that the petitioner and his wife are presently residing at Khanna in a rented accommodation and, therefore, the petitioner should approach the officials of Police Headquarters, Khanna, seeking security, if any.

Since FIR has been registered against respondent No.4, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having become infructuous.

However, the petitioner if still aggrieved, can approach the police for redressal of his grievance.
