HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 155 dated 02.12.2019 registered under Sections 61 of the Punjab Excise Act at Police Station Julkan, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted the benefit of interim bail by this Court on 20.12.2019 and the petitioner has already joined the investigation and the challan has already been submitted by the police. Order dated 20.12.2019 is as under:-

“As per allegations in the FIR, 20 boxes of country made liquor for sale in Haryana were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has falsely been involved as he was not arrested from the spot and that no recovery is to be effected from him.

Notice of motion for 02.03.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner is also directed to join the investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency, as and when required.”

Learned State counsel, who has also joined the proceedings through video conference, on instructions from ASI Narata Ram, states that in terms of the order of this Court reproduced before, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no further interrogation is required at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 20.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of
