Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.189 dated 08.08.2019, registered under Sections 452, 506, 120-B IPC(all offences deleted and subsequently offences under Sections 452, 120-B, 379, 380, 406, 148, 149 IPC and sections 25/27 of the Arms Act were added and now only offences under Section 420, 447 IPC remain) registered at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 20.12.2019, passed by this Court, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 20.12.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.12.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
