1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.157 dated 01.12.2019 at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur, under Sections 420/406/506/120-B IPC.
2. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties and that in fact a petition for quashing of the FIR in question has already been filed in this Court. It has further been informed that Mukesh Kumar and Ramesh Kumar, brothers of the present petitioner, have already been granted bail by this Court, whereas another accused Nauhar Chand i.e. father of the petitioner and other 2 accused, had already expired.

3. In view of the aforesaid position, wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties, the petition is accepted and the petitioner, in the event of arrest, shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
