This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.418 dated 11.09.2019, under Sections 406 & 420 Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dabua, District Faridabad. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 26.08.2020, whereby, while issuing notice of motion to respondent-State, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

*“Case taken up through video conferencing.
CRM-18115-2020*

This is an application for preponing the date of hearing of the main case fixed for 26.8.2020 i.e. today to some earlier date.

The application is dismissed being infructuous since the case is being taken up today i.e. 26.8.2020.

CRM-18117-2020

This is an application for placing on record the copy of draft as Annexure P-3.

Heard.

The application is allowed and the document is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that to show his bona-fide the petitioner has got prepared the demand draft in the sum of Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of the complainant and photocopy of which has been placed on record. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 28.9.2020.

Under the circumstances, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within seven days from today and render all sort of co-operation. The petitioner is to surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. If in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. The original draft would be handed over by the petitioner to the Investigating Officer, who shall then give it to the complainant against proper receipt. The Court be informed in that regard.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by HC Udeyveer does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim

bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.08.2020 is made absolute.
