Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 284 dated 01.05.2018, under Sections 506 IPC and Section 6 of The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station Sector-55, Faridabad.

By virtue of the order dated 02.08.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that
