Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.118 dated 9.4.2018 registered under Sections 376, 420 IPC at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.
