Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.0060 dated 16.03.2019 under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 341 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Line Sirsa, District Sirsa. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel has argued that as per prosecution, the injury suffered by the victim is attributed to Jagjit Singh and the petitioner, but after investigation, the said accused (Jagjit Singh) has been declared innocent. He has further argued that incidentally, the said occurrence was captured by CCTV footage and in the same, the petitioner is not identified. He states that pursuant to the order dated 06.01.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from PSI Barlin, states

that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more

required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.01.2020 is made absolute.
