Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.67 dated 28.03.2019, under Sections 326, 324, 427, 452, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 54 and 59 of Arms Act added later on) registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural, Amritsar.

Vide order dated 26.12.2019, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order

dated 26.12.2019 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
