The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 168 dated 03.12.2019 under Sections 341, 294, 323, 506, 34, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Shambhu District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on instructions of this Court dated 08.01.2020, he has joined the investigation. Apart from that the dispute *inter se* the parties stand settled and a quashing petition has already been filed which is fixed for 23.08.2021.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohar Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

In view of the facts that the matter has been investigated qua the petitioner and the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
