The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.798 dated 26.11.2019 registered under Sections 494, 498A, 323, 506/34 IPC at Police Station Model Town, Rewari District Rewari.

It being a matrimonial dispute between the parties, vide order dated, 17.12.2020, the matter was referred to the Mediator at Rohtak and the parties were directed to appear there on 9.2.2021. A communication dated 3.3.2021 has been received from the Mediator, Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Rohtak along with the report.

As per the report, parties have amicably settled their dispute and a compromise has been reduced in writing, which is attached as Exhibit

C-1 with the report. The same is made part of record.

Noticing the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the present petition is hereby disposed of, at this stage, as rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioner shall not be arrested in the present case unless a clear 15 days notice is served upon him enabling him to avail his remedies as available under law.
