The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the life and liberty of the petitioner be protected as the same is in danger at the hands of respondent No.4.

After the notice of motion was issued, the reply has been filed by the respondent-State, in which, it has been mentioned that a complaint has been received against the petitioner regarding occupying the properties of others and selling the same. The State has denied that the petitioner is being harassed in any manner.

Today, during the course of virtual hearing, learned State counsel on instructions from S.I., Sulakhan Singh, Police Station Moti

Nagar, Ludhiana submits that an FIR has already been registered against the petitioner being FIR No.129 dated 03.05.2020 under Sections 384, 506, 341, 269, 188, 148 IPC at Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana and in the said case, the challan has already been presented and, therefore, the question of harassing the petitioner does not arise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the reply filed on behalf of the respondent-State and the statement made by the learned State counsel recorded hereinbefore, the petitioner does not press the present petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.
