This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.376 dated 08.12.2019 under Section 406 Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the Court to the order dated 03.02.2020, whereby, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner. The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegations are mainly against Ravinder co-accused of the petitioner who has since been arrested and petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation.

Under such circumstances, the petitioner is directed to join investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within 5 days from today and

render all sort of cooperation. The petitioner has to surrender his Passport before the Investigating Officer, if he has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. The next date of hearing is fixed as 30.3.2020. If, in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

In the meanwhile, learned State counsel may file reply and place on file the other F.I.Rs said to have been registered against the petitioner.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in deference to the said order, the petitioner submitted himself before the Police and joined the investigation. According to him, the petitioner cooperated with the Police Authorities during the investigation and furnished requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by ESI Jagdish does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 03.02.2020 is made absolute.
