1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

CONT.APP.(C) 14/2021 and CM APPL. 42478/2021 [Application filed on behalf of the appellant for stay on the operation of the order dated 06.08.2021]

2. This is an appeal filed against the interlocutory order dated 10.11.2021, passed by the learned single judge in Cont. Case (C) 572/2020.

2.1. Apart from the fact that we have serious doubts that an appeal against such an order can be maintained, according to us, the best way forward in the matter is to approach the learned single judge.

2.2. To be noted, the impugned order dated 10.11.2021 was passed in an application for early hearing, in which notice has been issued, returnable on 23.02.2022.

3. Ms. Preeti Singh, who appears on behalf of the appellant, says that, early hearing is sought as, while the appellant has no difficulty with the order dated 06.08.2021 passed by the learned single judge, there is some

difficulty being faced by the appellant, as regards the timings indicated therein.

3.1 Ms. Singh says that, since the appellant is working with a multi-national company (in short “MNC”), the meetings stipulated on a working day, between the mother and daughter, would cause complications for the appellant.

3.2. As indicated above, since the learned single judge is seized of the matter, the difficulty encountered can be placed before the learned single judge.

4. Therefore, we find no reason to interfere with the impugned order dated 10.11.2021.

5. The appeal is accordingly closed. Consequently, pending application shall also stand closed.
