the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Nayagaon P.S. Case No. 162 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under sections 304B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case merely because they are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased. Nothing specific is alleged against the petitioners. The husband of the deceased is in custody. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Nayagaon P.S. Case No. 162 of 2020 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
