learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in  
  
a case registered for the offences punishable under  
  
Sections 302, 120(B), 34 of the Indian Penal Code and  
  
Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case as per F.I.R is that all the  
  
F.I.R named accused persons including petitioners,  
  
variously armed surrounded the uncle of the informant  
  
and co-accused Puttu Singh fired at the uncle of the  
  
informant, as a result of which, he sustained gunshot



injuries and succumbed to the injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that there is general and omnibus allegation against the informant and eleven other accused persons to have ordered to kill the deceased. The specific accusation of firing is against co-accused Puttu Singh. From perusal of the postmortem report annexed with the case diary, it appears that cause of death is firearm. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, IV, Patna City, Patna in connection with Bypass P.S. Case No. 14 of 2020, subject to the



conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the  
Cr.P.C.
