The petitioner has approached this Court against the order of cancellation of her licence without exhausting the alternative remedy of appeal.

In case an appeal is filed by the petitioner within next thirty days, that shall be taken up for consideration by the appellate authority and after affording all



opportunities to the petitioner, the same shall be disposed of within a period of sixty days thereafter by a reasoned order. If the petitioner still feels aggrieved by the order passed by the appellate authority, he may take recourse to the remedies available to him under the law.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
