2 06-07-2022 Though, the present writ petition has been filed for quashing the encroachment proceedings initiated vide Encroachment Case No. 92 and 93 of 2019-20 by the Circle Officer, Dawath, however, the learned counsel for the petitioner has confined his relief to the extent of liberty being granted to the petitioner to file reply to the show cause notice before the Circle Officer, Dawath and in the meantime some protection be granted to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file reply to the show cause



notice within a period of four weeks from today, in the ongoing Encroachment Case No. 92 and 93 of 2019-20, in case the proceedings of the same have not already been concluded, whereafter the Circle Officer, Dawath shall consider the same and after hearing the effected party shall pass appropriate order in accordance with law u/s 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 within a period of four weeks thereafter.

It is needless to state that for a period of eight weeks from today, status quo existing as on today shall be maintained.
