through Video Conference.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is expected to honour
his undertaking given in the instant case for depositing the
requisite court fee and to remove the defects as pointed out by
office when called upon to do so by the office.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Dhanarua P. S. Case No. 542
of 2019, instituted for the offence under Section 304B/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

While the petitioner has been in custody, his prayer for
bail was earlier rejected under order dated 03.06.2020 passed



in Cr. Misc. No. 12792 of 2020. Therefore, after some argument, he submits that he will be approaching the learned Court below renewing his prayer for bail.

This Court would only observe that if the petitioner applies for bail, the period of custody and other aspect of the matter be considered by the learned trial Court without in any manner being effected by the earlier rejection under order dated 03.06.2020 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 12792 of 2020.

With the aforesaid observations, the application stands disposed of.
