2 20-07-2022 The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that during the pendency of the present writ petition, a fresh notice under Section 3 of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act, 1956') dated 28.12.2020 has been issued to the petitioner to which the petitioner has also filed a reply dated 11.01.2021, hence it is submitted that the same may be considered by the Circle Officer, Sadar Chapra and he be directed to take a final decision, in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the Circle Officer, Sadar Chapra to



consider the objection/show cause reply filed by the petitioner,
which is at Annexure-6 to the I.A. filed today and pass
appropriate final order, in accordance with law.
