Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a
period of four weeks from today.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Sarai P.S. Case No. 214/2021 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise Act and Section 272/273 of the Indian Penal Code.

This is a case of huge recovery of illicit liquor. It
seems that the petitioner is a member of liquor syndicate.
Petitioner is named in the self inculpatory statement of the co-



accused.

In view of the fact that *prima facie* a case under the Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)*.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as not maintainable.
