The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Sono P.S. Case No. 291 of 2019 dated 07.10.2019 instituted for the offences under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner and the informant are own brothers and there is a dispute between them with respect to partition of family property. The petitioner and others are said to have resorted to brick bats leading to simple injuries on two of the victims.

Regard being had to the background facts and the relationship of the parties, the petitioner is directed



to be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge 4th, Jamui in connection with Sono P.S. Case No. 291 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
