2 14-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 411/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 11/56 of the Bihar Mineral (Concession Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage), 21 of MMDR Act, 1959 and Section 12 of the EP Act.

It is a case of illegal mining of sand, transportation and storage by the accused persons due to which the State Government suffered a loss of Rs.62,229/.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner has deposited Rs.62,229/-



against the loss suffered by the government as stated in para-7 of the petition. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-X, Patna in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 201 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
