6 24-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Sahajitpur P.S. Case No. 118 of 2020 registered under Section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner is on Police Bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it appears that the matter is well covered by the decision of this Court in the case of *Mahendra Prasad Singh Vs. State of Bihar*, reported in *2004(3) P.L.J.R., 491*.

In view of the above, it is directed that petitioner may

surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today. In case, petitioner surrender and file an application for bail, the concerned Court will pass an order in the similar manner as has been decided in the case of Mahendra Prasad Singh (Supra).

With the above directions/observations, this application is disposed of.
