The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No. 241 of 2020 instituted for the offences under Sections 341, 323, 498(A), 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code and 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

Case diary has not been received.

Notice issued has been refused to receive.

Taking into consideration that the notice was issued to the wife who has refused to receive, not ready to appear before this court. Learned counsel submits that it is a matrimonial dispute which amicably resolved, I am inclined to grant benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and in the event of arrest he

shall be released on bail subject to the conditions as laid down
under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
