ORAL ORDER

3 22-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Excise
Case No. 109 of 2018 registered under Section-18(b)/8(c) of
NDPS Act and 30(a)/56(d) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise
Act, 2016.

Earlier prayer for bail of the petitioner was rejected
vide Annexure-1 to the present application taking into account
that there was recovery of 20 kg. of opium and the petitioner
was not entitled for bail under the provisions of Section-37 of
NDPS Act.

A report has been called for from the trial court.

It has been reported that out of nine prosecution



witnesses, three prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the trial is likely to be concluded within a period of four months.

Considering the nature of accusation and stage of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

The trial court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of five months from the date of receipt/production of copy of the order.
