ORAL ORDER

(Per: HONOURABLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE)

2 07-03-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- i. For issuance of an appropriate write nature of mandamus direction commanding the respondents to make payment of work done by all ULBS and Nagar Nigam arrear due of Rs. 1,86,34,543/- (Rupees One Crore Eighty Six Lakh Thirty Four Thousand Five Hundred Forty Three).
- ii. Make payment of Excess GST liability of Rs. 93,65,920/- (Rupees Ninty Three Lakh Sixty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty).



- iii. Make payment of Rs. 21,21,265(Rupees Twenty One Lakh, Twenty One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Five) is providing services as Professional Communication Agency for Development and Provisioning of Information Education and Communication (IEC) activities for Urban Development and Housing Department, Bihar Patna under work order no. 596 letter no. 03/SBM-01-14/2016 of 2016 but it was wrongly typed Tender No. 03/SBM-01-16/2016.
- iv. For issuance of mandamus directing to the respondents to the case of petitioner to make payment of dues of above said claim in Para – I/II/III of the petitioner under Urban Development and housing Department, Government of Bihar.
- v. For issuance of an appropriate writ/ order direction in favour of the petitioner as your lordship may deem fit and proper in facts and circumstances of the case.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not to be in favour with the submissions made across the Bar, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition reserving liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and/or to take recourse to such other alternative remedies, equally efficacious in law.



Permission granted.

We are sure that as and when any such proceedings are initiated, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory Application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
