Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s).

“1.That the present writ application is being filed with prayer to issuance of writ in nature of mandamus or any appropriate writ order and direction to direct the respondent authorities to fulfill the insurance claim of

fifteen lakh Rupees after the death of the owner of the vehicle namely Avinash Kumar who is the son of the Informant which was purchased by the son of the petitioner Baja Pulsar Motorcycle dated on 31.10.2019 bearing Reg. No. BR 26R 7528, Chasis No. MD2A11CY1KRB05599, Engine No. DHYRKB85381 from the Baja Allianz General Insurance Company Limited Gaya.”

After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the appropriate/competent forum for redressal of his grievances as permissible in law.

This application is dismissed as withdrawn reserving liberty to the writ petitioner to take recourse to such remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.
