2 14-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Sasaram (T) P.S. Case no. 251 of 2021 instituted for the
offence under Section 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, petitioner is a member of
gang, which is involved in stealing the motorcycle.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. He has got no criminal antecedent. The name of the
petitioner has been disclosed in this case by the co-accused,
namely, Gaurav Singh who was arrested on spot, which has got
no evidentiary value in the eye of law. Nothing has been
recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. Neither



the petitioner was arrested nor any incriminating article has been recovered from his possession.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Sasaram (T) P.S. Case no. 251 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Rohtas at Sasaram subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
