APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is a case of assaulting due to which informant and his son sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that there is general and omnibus allegation against her and petitioner is a lady. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions as well as the fact that petitioner being a lady, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-XIII, Saran at Chapra in connection with Jalalpur P.S. Case No. 185 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
