1. That this is an application for issuance of a appropriate writ(s), order(s) direction(s) for commanding the respondents concern for payment of admitted outstanding dues against the work already done by petitioner under agreement no. 124F2 year 2015-2016 for work of repairing and washing of Sub-Registrar Office at Dalsingsarai, work already completed on 02.03.2016.



Thereafter measurement of work measured and entered in measurement book accordingly checked and bill of work prepared valued of Rs. 2,01,928/- (Rupees Two lac one thousand nine hundred twenty eight), but till date payment of same has not been done inspite of representation/applications of the petitioner, it is prayed that for payment of said outstanding dues alongwith the interest upon the bill amount, from the date of bill to its actual realization.
