*For issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent no. 4 to initiate the encroachment proceedings against the private*



*respondents/Encroachers and decide the encroachment case to its logical conclusion within short span of time by removing the encroachment made by encroachers/private respondents over the Chak Khata No. 193, Chak Plot No. 746/R.S. Plot No. 908 area 4 decimal, Chak Plot No. 752/R.S. Plot No. 913, area 1 decimal, Chak Plot No. 757/R.S. Plot No. 951, area 6 decimal, Chak Plot No. 790/R.S. Plot No. 953, area 16 decimal, Chak Plot No. 751/R.S. Plot No. 582 and Chak Plot No. 328/R.S. Plot No. 449, Chak Plot No. 844/R.S. Plot No. 949 situated in village-Bhadaula, Thana No. 626, Block-Kudra, District-Kaimur, which is state Government land.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to move the Circle Officer- Kudra, Distirct-Kaimur at Bhabua i.e. the respondent no. 3 for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.

Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands disposed off.
