Petitioners apprehend their arrest in Saraiya P.S. Case No.594 of 2019 registered under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a) (d) (f) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from possession of the petitioner rather recovery has been made from *janera* field as is evident from seizure list. The petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the above facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing personal bonds to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Saraiya P.S. Case No.594 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
