Sucheta Yadav learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Danapur
P.S. Case No. 482 of 2021 instituted for the offences under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Amendment
Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2021 is a person with clean
antecedent, charge-sheet has been submitted in the case and
allegation is of recovery of 500 liters of liquor from an Auto.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner was a passenger and as such was not knowing who
had kept the liquor in the Auto.



Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2021 is a person with clean antecedent and charge-sheet has been submitted in the case, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Patna in connection with Danapur P.S. Case No. 482 of 2021.
