Similarly, at page 12 in paragraph 14 of the said judgment “27.11.2003” has been typed in place of “27.11.2013”. There is yet another apparent typographical error in the 7th line of page 16 wherein “Title Execution Case No. 754 of 1985” has been typed in place of “Title Execution Case No. 74 of 1985”.

Let necessary corrections to the aforesaid effect be incorporated in the said judgment and order dated 03.12.2018, passed in Second Appeal No. 60 of 2009 and Second Appeal No. 59 of 2009.
