learned APP for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

a case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 341, 342, 323, 337, 308, 427, 504, 506/34 of

the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged against the petitioners that they

assaulted the informant and her son, as a result of

which, they sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioners that petitioners have falsely been implicated



in this case. There is counter version of the occurrence also and petitioners' side also received injuries. There is no accusation of repeating the blow.

In the facts and circumstance of the case, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousands) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Masaurhi in connection with Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 24 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
