ORAL ORDER

3 24-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State through virtual court proceedings.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Kateya P.S.
Case No.256 of 2020, registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are said to have killed the son of the
informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the
present case. It is submitted that there is no eye witness in the
present case. Merely on suspicion, the petitioners have been
made accused in the case.



Learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners and submitted that the petitioners have killed the son of the informant.

Having considered the submissions of the parties and on perusal of the records including the case diary, this Court finds that there is ample evidence in the case diary against the petitioners to show their involvement in the alleged offence, therefore, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.
