petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period  
of four weeks from today.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Town  
(Begusarai) P.S. Case No. 657 of 2021 registered for the offence  
under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120(B) and 34 of the  
Indian Penal Code.

The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R. and is in  
custody since 30.10.2021.

The allegation against the petitioner to run a fake  
company, along with other co-accused persons, to extort money  
from unemployed persons.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner  
submitted that alleged company registered in the name of this  
petitioner but entire affairs was under control of her husband,  
where petitioner is an innocent lady and a house wife. It is  
further submitted that thrust of allegation is against co-accused,  
Rishi Kumar Satyam, who is husband of this petitioner. While



concluding the argument, it is submitted that petitioner is lady of clean antecedent and, moreover, investigation in this case is complete, for which, charge-sheet has been submitted, as such, there is no chance of tampering with the evidence.

Learned APP appearing on behalf of the State opposes the prayer of bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances as mentioned above, as petitioner is lady of clean antecedent coupled with the fact that charge-sheet has already been submitted, let the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail in connection with Town (Begusarai) P.S. Case No. 657 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Begusarai/concerned court, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 437(3) of the Cr.P.C.
