This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Sadar (Muffasil) P.S. Case No. 570 of 2021 registered for the offence under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal code and under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Prohibition Act.

In view of the fact that prima facie a case under the Excise Act, is made out against the petitioners, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar* reported in *2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)*.



Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
