6 17-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the opposite parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 831(C) of 2018 registered under
Sections 498 (A), 323 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that both
the parties have compromised the case and opposite party no. 2
(wife) is residing with the petitioner (husband). In support
thereof, a supplementary affidavit has been filed. Petitioner has
no criminal antecedent.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing personal bond to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Supaul in connection with Complaint Case No. 831(C) of 2018, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
