the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Runnisaidpur P.S. Case No. 547 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under section 30(a), 30(g), 41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of these petitioners as is evident from the seizure list. Petitioners are men of clean antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case

and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing of his personal bond to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with Runnisaidpur P.S. Case No. 547 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
