6 08-08-2022 Heard the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceedings. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within stipulated period, office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 420/468 and 471 of the IPC.

Vide order dated 07.03.2022, petitioner was directed to be released on provisional bail and notice was issued upon the O.P. No.2. Thereafter, twice, notice has been sent to the O.P. No.2 but as per the office notes, notice has not been received by him and undelivered registered cover with A/D has returned.

Under the aforesaid circumstance, the provisional bail



granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.03.2022, in connection with Complaint Case No.576 (C)/2017 is hereby confirmed, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
