Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s).

“ 1. That this is an application for issuance of Writ(s), order(s) or direction (s) to the Respondents specially the Respondent No.2 to refund the money i.e. amounting to Rs. 40 lacs in the account of Turbotech Infranet Pvt. Ltd. A/c No. 655705503173 which was transferred by the petitioner's firm mistakenly in the account to Avighna Enterprises A/c No. 510101006448259 of Respondents Bank Branch- Phulwari Sharif on 21.12.2021 and 24.12.2021.”

After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the appropriate/competent forum including DRT or consumer forum for redressal of his grievances as permissible in law.

This application is dismissed as withdrawn reserving liberty to the writ petitioner to take recourse to such remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.

However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and all issues of facts and law are left open.
