2 04-03-2022 Heard Mr. Rikesh Sinha, learned Advocate for the
petitioners and the learned APP.

The petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Sigori P.S. Case No. 49 of 2020 dated 13.03.2020 instituted for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 324 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation against the petitioners is of assaulting the father of the informant and others who came to his rescue.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the injuries suffered by the victims are reported to be simple



in nature.

There is a counter version of the occurrence also lodged by one Bablu Kumar, who is the son of petitioner no. 3 *vide* Sigori P.S. Case No. 48 of 2020 against the informant and others.

There has been a delay of two days in lodging the FIR.

Considering the afore-noted facts, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-V, Danapur in connection with Sigori P.S. Case No. 49 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
