Though the present writ petition has been



filed challenging the order dated 18.1.2022, passed by the Circle Officer, Bairiya, District-West Champaran at Bettiah, whereby and whereunder the caste certificate issued to the petitioner on 1.4.2016 has been cancelled, however, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the State Level Caste Scrutiny Committee, Bihar, Patna, for redressal of his said grievances, however, submits that it be directed that the cancellation of the caste certificate of the petitioner by the Respondent No. 10 shall be subject to the final outcome of the case, to be filed by the petitioner before the State Level Caste Scrutiny Committee, Bihar, Patna.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the State Level Caste Scrutiny Committee, Bihar, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances, however, it is directed that the final outcome of the proceedings, to be initiated by the petitioner before the State Level Caste Scrutiny Committee, Bihar, Patna, shall



govern the order passed by the Respondent No.
10, as aforesaid.
