The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.32 of 2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376, 323, 341, 420, 120(B), 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the statement of the girl under Section 164 of the Cr.P.C. that she got married to the petitioner, the present anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner above named be



released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.32 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
