Kumar, learned AC to SC 8 for the State.

The petitioner in the present writ application is
seeking following reliefs:-

“ I. For issuance of writ in the nature
of Mandamus or any other appropriate
writ/writs or direction/directions commanding
the respondent no. 4 & 5 to provide security of
the property of the petitioner.

II. For issuance of writ in the nature
of Mandamus or any other appropriate



writ/writs or direction/directions commanding the respondent no. 4 a& 5 for taking appropriate action against the accused persons in connection with Krityanand Nagar (Shri Nagar) Police Station Case No. 128 of 2017 dt. 01.04.2017 bearing G.R. No. 1138/2017.

III. For issuance of any other relief/reliefs to which the petitioner may be found entitled too in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that there is a civil dispute with respect to the possession of the property in question.

In such circumstance, this writ application cannot be entertained. It is disposed of accordingly with liberty to the petitioner to seek his remedy in appropriate jurisdiction.
